**David B. Fleming**

**President & CEO**

**REV Birmingham**

David Fleming is President and CEO of REV Birmingham, a place-based revitalization agency and economic development nonprofit. REV's mission is to create vibrant commercial districts by filling vacant spaces and growing sustainable businesses.

REV was formed in 2012 by the strategic merger of Operation New Birmingham and Main Street Birmingham. David was the founding Executive Director of Main Street Birmingham, Inc., a non-profit organization created to target nine older neighborhood commercial districts for revitalization and development.

David is a native of Birmingham having graduated from Vestavia Hills High School in 1990. He received a Bachelor's in History at Samford University and a Masters in Public and Private Management from Birmingham-Southern College. His professional career has included several years working previously with Operation New Birmingham and stints with Sloss Real Estate Group and Congressman Spencer Bachus in Washington, D.C.

He has served as Chairman of the Birmingham Planning Commission, on the Metropolitan Planning Organization, and as an officer in a neighborhood association. He was recognized several years ago by the Birmingham Business Journal as a Top 40 under 40 in Birmingham and by the Birmingham Business Alliance as Small Business Advocate of the Year.

David and his wife Brooke have a young son, Thomas. They live in the Crestwood neighborhood of Birmingham and are members of Cathedral Church of the Advent.
